Elena S. Gvozdeva, Master of Arts (University of Manchester, 1998), Bachelor of Science (Novosibirsk State University, 1997) was recognized as the winner of the Competition of Young Researchers of Russia two times (1997, 2000), and received the State Scientific scholarship for six consecutive years. In 2002 she received the Second Academic Prize from the Governor of the Siberian Region. In 2003 she became the winner of the Competition “The Most Active Certificated Young Scholar of Russia” and received the First Prize. Since 1993 Elena has been working with non-governmental women’s organizations in the Siberian region, where she organized and facilitated series of workshops and actions on behalf of international women’s organizations. Currently she is working in the Institute of Economics of Siberian Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences as a Ph.D. researcher; in 2002 she was elected the Head of the Council of Young Scientists. She is also involved in capacity of Assistant Director of the Leadership Development Institute at Siberian Academy of Public Administration (NGO).
